PURPOSE OF

THE TRAINING: THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE REQUIRED BASIC CONCEPT AND THEORY INFORMATION TO GIVE CARE TO A PATIENT/INDIVIDUAL WHO NEEDS HEALTHCARE WITH INDIVIDUAL AND HOLISTIC APPROACH IN ACCORDANCE WITH NURSING PROCESS AND TO PROVIDE KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL FOR BASIC NURSING INTERVENTIONS TO MAINTAIN DAILY ACTIVITIES OF AN INDIVIDUAL.
