PURPOSE OF

THE TRAINING: THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS TO STUDENTS ABOUT THE BASIC CONCEPTS OF OPERATING ROOM AND OPERATING ROOM NURSING, ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF OPERATING ROOM NURSES AND OTHER SURGICAL TEAM MEMBERS, AND ABOUT THE MATTERS RELATED TO PERFORMING SURGICAL INTERVENTION WITHIN SAFE CONDITIONS.
