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### PURPOSE OF

**THE TRAINING:** THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS FOR THE PHYSICAL, PSYCHOSOCIAL AND SPIRITUAL NEEDS OF BOTH PATIENT AND HIS/HER RELATIVES DURING THE PERIOD OF DIOGNOSIS, COURSE OF TREATMENT, UNTIL THE MOMENT OF DEATH AND DURING THE GRIEF PROCESS, ESPECIALLY FOR PATIENTS FOR WHOM TREATMENT APPROACHES RAN OUT.
