PROCESS OF

(ACQUISITIONS)** : AT THE END OF THIS TRAINING PROGRAM, PARTICIPANTS ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE ;

- ABILITY TO DETERMINE IMPORTANT AND PRIOR HEALTH PROBLEMS AND HIGH RISK GROUPS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF CHILD DEVELOPMENT
- ABILITY TO EXPLAIN BASIC CARE NEEDS OF HEALTHY NEWBORN/INFANT/CHILD
- ABILITY TO EXPLAIN THE IMPORTANCE OF IMPROVING THE HEALTH OF BABIES /CHILDREN AND THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE NURSE
- ABILITY TO EXPLAIN THE PHYSICAL EXAMINATION STEPS OF BABIES/CHILDREN
- ABILITY TO ADMINISTER MEDICATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STEPS OF THE INFANT/CHILD GUIDELINES.
