- PSYCHOSOCIAL NURSING IN GENERAL PATIENT CARE
 - PSYCHOSOCIAL REACTIONS GIVEN TO A DISEASE
 - PSYCHOSOCIAL SKILLS
 - KEY ISSUES IN RESPONDING TO DISEASE (CHANGE IN SELF-ESTEEM, CHANGE IN THE BODY IMAGE, WEAKNESS, GUILT, HOPELESSNESS, LOSS)
 - MANAGING PATIENT BEHAVIORS CAUSING DIFFICULTIES
 - DIFFICULTIES EXPERIENCED BY PATIENT'S FAMILY AND APPROACH TO PATIENT'S FAMILY
 - APPROACH TO A PATIENT WITH SPIRITUAL DISTRESS
 - PSYCHOSOCIAL MANAGEMENT OF SPECIFIC CONDITIONS : "PATIENT DIAGNOSED WITH CANCER"
 - PSYCHOSOCIAL MANAGEMENT OF SPECIFIC CONDITIONS : "PATIENT DIAGNOSED WITH AIDS"
 - PSYCHOSOCIAL MANAGEMENT OF SPECIFIC CONDITIONS : ORGAN TRANSPLANTATION"
